I was selfishly proud when the Lord used one of my own disciples, and I became jealous when the Lord moved through anyone who was outside of my ministry. I would search for anything that was wrong with them in order to expose them. I did not know that every time I did this I only demoted myself further."

"I did not do it myself, but I incited men under me to investigate other ministers and do my dirty work . . . We sowed fear and division throughout the church, all in the name of protecting the truth"
