Recap of previous lessons

In order to overcome the enemy, we who are part of God's army should do these three things:

- 1) Unity in all relationships, since the devil's strategy is to cause divisions among Christians,
- 2) Put on the whole armor of God. This we do by becoming rooted and grounded in the Word of God which is both offensive and defensive,
- 3) Grow spiritually until we attain the highest level of "The Father's Unconditional Love." The Father's unconditional love is the greatest weapon there is and ever will be, and at that level, we can never fail.
- We are God's children, and our Father God loves us the same exact way He loves Jesus (Romans 8:15-17 and John 17:23,24)
- When we are persuaded that we are dearly loved and that unconditionally, we then understand that we are invincible (Romans 8:35-39)
- We must therefore pray for the comprehension of the extent of the love our Father has for us (Ephesians 3:14-19).

Worship

Faith

Rick Joyner: When I opened them (eyes), I was surprised to see that the Lord was not there any longer . . . One of them (angels) said, "Close your eyes again." When I did, I beheld the glory of the Lord. ... Then the angels explained, "What you see with the eyes of your heart is more real than what you see with your physical eyes."

2 Corinthians 4:18 faith considers the invisible.

Hebrews 11:27 Moses endured by seeing the invisible.

Romans 4:18-21 Abraham believed the invisible against the visible.
